FLEX PLAN TICKETS

These days, scheduling your entertainment months ahead of time can be more challenging than ever. We're offering Flex Tickets so you get the benefit of subscriber prices with the flexibility to reserve your seat only when you're ready. And, once you purchase a Flex Plan, you can use it however you like—see five shows once, or watch the same show five times, it's up to you! Here's how it works:

1. You decide which Flex Plan is right for you.
2. Fill out the order form, and provide payment.
3. You will receive a unique purchase code, generated specifically for you (we keep records in case you lose track of it).
4. When you're ready, go to our ticketing website. Select your show(s) and your seat(s). Enter the code as payment for your tickets. If you purchased a Flex-5, for example, your code will allow you to redeem up to five (5) tickets. The tickets can be purchased together or separately, whatever works best for you.

In the Next Room (or The Vibrator Play)
(March 17—April 2, 2023)

In the Next Room, or The Vibrator Play, is a comedy about marriage, intimacy, and electricity. Set in the 1880s at the dawn of the age of electricity and based on the bizarre historical fact that doctors used vibrators to treat 'hysterical' women (and some men), the play centers on a doctor and his wife and how his new therapy affects their entire household. In a seemingly perfect, well-to-do Victorian home, proper gentleman and scientist Dr. Givings has innocently invented an extraordinary new device: the vibrator. Adjacent to the doctor's laboratory, his young and energetic wife tries to tend to their newborn daughter—and wonders exactly what is going on in the next room. When a new "hysterical" patient and her husband bring a wet nurse and their own complicated relationship into the doctor's home, Dr. and Mrs. Givings must examine the nature of their own marriage, and what it truly means to love someone.



Reefer Madness the Musical
(June 2—18, 2023)

Inspired by the original 1936 film of the same name, this raucous musical comedy takes a tongue-in-cheek look at the frenzied panic caused when clean-cut kids fall prey to marijuana, leading them on a hysterical downward spiral filled with evil jazz music, sex, and violence. You won't be able to resist the spoofy fun of *Reefer Madness*. The addictive, clever musical numbers range from big Broadway-style showstoppers to swing tunes like "Down at the Ol' Five and Dime" and the Vegas-style "Listen to Jesus, Jimmy," featuring J.C. Himself leading a chorus of showgirl angels. *Reefer Madness* is a highly stylized and satirical political commentary that will leave you wanting more. Dan Studney (Music, Book): "*This show is an equal opportunity offender. It's not a show that's anti-Jesus, it's not a show that's anti-flag, it's not a show that's racist, it's not a show that's ageist, and it's not a show that's homophobic. But all those things are laid out. Ultimately, the truth is we're against people that use the flag or Jesus or fears of homophobia or racism to force you to do something.*"

Alice plunges down the rabbit hole and becomes involved in that madcap and deliciously satiric series of adventures immortalized by Lewis Carroll. Dramatized as a series of episodes from *Alice in Wonderland* and *Through the Looking Glass*, we're offering this alternative summer theatre experience for children and teens ages 8 through 18, rehearsing in the evenings from 6pm to 8pm in June and July, and culminating in an exciting weekend of performances. This production will be designed to offer opportunities for young people who want to be onstage as well as those who prefer to stay behind the curtain, helping in areas such as creating the sets, props, and costumes. A kaleidoscope of action and madness, with the necessary elements of suspense and frustration to make it all work!
